Comments: In 1911 Charles was married and working as a Stockman on a Farm
When he enlisted his occupation is given as Groom, and he had four children,
William, Edith, Lily and Leslie ,and he wished to transfer to the Army Service
Corps, if required.
Posted to the Norfolk Regiment on 1st June 1915, he was transferred to the
Border Regiment on 9th November 1915, and to the 2nd Battalion
on 1st January 1916.
Alfred was wounded on 2nd July 1916 and taken to 34th Casualty Clearing
Station, with GSWs (Gun Shot Wounds) to thigh and abdomen. He died at
38th Casualty Clearing Station on 5th July 1916.

Medals: Alfred was awarded the 1914/15 Star
British War Medal and Victory Medal.
