When Robert died in 1916 his older brother Charles was in a hospital in Ontario, Canada, Wilfred was in the Army, and Elsie his sister was living in Norwich. On the Roll of Honour Charles is listed as Canadian Mounted Rifles, and Wilfred the Yorkshire Regiment. Robert enlisted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Royal Sussex Regiment on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1916, and was transferred to "B" Coy, 22<sup>nd</sup> Manchester Regiment on 14<sup>th</sup>

October 1916.
